

#### TIPS TO TRACK A LATE BUS for Kinder to Grade 6:

Here are some useful tips to help all parents track a late school bus:



- 1. LIVE! Yellow Bus Delay App
- 2. **Bus Finder** located in PowerSchool Parent Portal under Bus Information, select the Bus Finder tab. Bus Finder will track the bus assigned to your route by GPS.
- 3. Call Transportation Services directly if your bus is running more than 10 minutes late! **780-441-**
