Planning for the 2025/2026 school year

A great deal of time and effort goes into creating balanced learning groups for each class. Teachers take into consideration a number of criteria: **Ability Distribution** – We strive to create a class grouping with a balanced range of abilities.

Gender Balance – It is important to strive for gender balance as much as possible in each class grouping.

Support System – Each year children make new friends, but it is important for them to have peer support as they move into a new grouping.

Work Ethic – Some students are highly independent, and others require more support. It is important to have a mixture of different types of learners to create a supportive learning environment.

Behaviour – a mixture of students who require support and those who can act as strong role models creates a more positive learning environment. **Children with Exceptional Needs** – It is important to have a balance of students who require academic challenge and support among the class groupings.

Children will encounter a variety of teacher personalities and styles as they move throughout their school experience. Often changes occur during the school year. It is important for us to create strong, balanced learning groups that will support and encourage students to be the best that they can be under any circumstance.
